


Family Fun and Games

Funding for a new pond



Work on enlarging and re-lining the pond is well under way. While it will look rather bare over the winter, nature quickly returns and we look forward to having a good- sized pond with a good depth of water which will soon become, once again, a haven for wildlife. The FoLaR pond group will continue to manage the surrounding garden, including the boundary hedge, the deadhedge, the bird feeder, the path and any planting we might want to undertake. In late autumn, we will hold a second hedge-laying session, applying traditional hedge-laying techniques to a second length of fence (to the right of the gate). We will also prune the whole of the un-laid hedge, to create a tidier appearance.

Also in the Autumn, we will be meeting with the Council's new Bio-diversity officer (who is an expert on aquatic wildlife) to draw up a management plan for the pond. In addition to maintaining a healthy pond we also want to create learning opportunities for ourselves, for children and the wider community. 
Music on the Rec
